Elevate Your Images



Topic

This presentation is sure to introduce you to topics you probably have never considered or rarely do. In order to elevate our wildlife images, we must master our camera system, we must master our fieldcraft, we need to make the shift from field guide to fine art wildlife photographer, and we must master our post processing. All of these elements combine to push our art to our best ability and creative expression. Take advantage of Lee's 270 days of travel each of the last three years and learn from his successes and failures from photographing wildlife on five continents. This presentation is sure to inspire, educate, encourage, and entertain you in all areas of wildlife photography.

Bio

Lee began his photography experience as a child when his parents purchased a Ranger Ready camera, and they visited the Wichita Mountains Wildlife Refuge in Southwest Oklahoma. At age 16, his mother gave him a Canon AE-1 with a broken meter. He read John Shaw's *Nature Photography Field Guide* and learned the sunny F/16 rule. Using Kodachrome 64 and doing all the exposure calculations in his head, he was forced to learn using manual exposure mode with no assistance from a camera meter. Looking back, this was a huge blessing. He shot with Canon for 25 years until making the switch to Olympus (now OM System). After a year with the new system, he was invited to become an OM System Ambassador in 2019. This is one of the photography accomplishments of which he is most proud. "The OM System family of ambassadors, employees, and hobby photographers is an amazing group of people with whom I have the pleasuring of sharing many aspects of my photographic journey. I was recently named a Fotopro and Black Rapid Ambassador in 2025 and 2026 respectively!" He recently began offering workshops with Natural Selections Tours and on his own. He splits his time at home in the mountains of west Texas near Fort Davis, Texas and with his fiancé in Curitiba, Brazil.
