Topic

Artist-in-Residence (AIR) programs offer creative individuals a valuable opportunity to step away from their everyday surroundings and responsibilities, providing dedicated time and space for contemplation, exploration, creative output, and presentation. Danielle will share her journey, recounting how six residencies in five unique national parks have profoundly influenced her artistic growth. She will also explain how these programs operate and how an AIR experience could be an exceptional opportunity for you.

Bio

Danielle Austen is an award-winning professional fine art photographer specializing in creating intimate portraits of the environment, emphasizing abstracts within the landscape. She holds a BFA from Cornell University and an MS from the Newhouse School at Syracuse Univ. Danielle's work has graced the pages in various local, regional, and national publications, including Life Magazine's "The Year in Pictures".

Her artistic endeavors have led her to prestigious Artist-in-Residency programs across the United States, with six residencies hosted within the National Parks; Shenandoah, Rocky Mountain, Great Smoky Mountains, twice at Acadia, Everglades, and the seventh was a Full Fellowship recipient at the Vermont Studio Center. Her work has also been showcased in over four dozen national and international juried exhibitions and numerous group and solo exhibitions, most notably at the Monmouth Museum in Lincroft, NJ. In recognition of her artistic achievements, Danielle was named a 2025 Individual Artist Finalist by the New Jersey State Council on the Arts.
