Topic

Many photographers avoid using their flash units. They use them as a last resort to get a picture when there is low ambient light. In this workshop, you'll learn how to take advantage of small flash units and portable accessories to create quality, natural-looking, images.

This workshop will help you understand portable lighting, light modifiers, and lighting techniques and how to utilize them for better results when photographing events, portraits, still life, and various natural subjects. The equipment and techniques discussed will be demonstrated during the workshop. Topics covered include:

- TTL and manual flash modes
- Exposure metering and adding fill-flash to available light
- Slow sync speed and Rear Curtain sync
- · Wired and wireless off-camera flash
- Techniques for using a single flash to get natural-looking pictures
- Small light modifiers (e.g., reflectors, umbrellas)
